# NEW BEGINNINGZ

New Beginnings is an organization that incorporates all the areas of baby care and nurturing in a loving family environment. In 2000 they launched their "No 'Baby Stuff'..." stall with a goal where desperate mothers can safely leave unwanted babies rather than dumping them in ditches, fields, gutters, parks or streets. Their efforts are aimed at offering desperate mothers and families babies as safe alternative & an opportunity to live.

Grand Gateway Gateway aims to engage in the relief and help to provide devoted homes to the less fortunate children who are found and declared to be abandoned, neglected and neglected. The focus of this CBI programme is aimed at the upliftment of communities through social skills development, health & safety and empowerment. Due to the increasing numbers of abandoned, neglected and abused babies in need of care and understanding the social implications of running a Home like this, they have provided funding to New Beginnings in order for them to accommodate and care for more babies.

Grand Gateway Gateway has donated R200 000 to New Beginnings. To date, Grand Gateway Gateway has donated over R200 000 to the organization which has ensured continuous care for more than 700 Babies & Toddlers. Furthermore, the funds would then help paying the salaries of their full-time caregivers that provide education for the children. The funds have also ensured that kids receive their 2 meals per day, 2 meals, milk & infant formulae, bottles, nappies, toiletries, medications, clinic visits and services for beyond ordinary day care centers.



# COMPASS

Compass offers a rehabilitation program for homeless women and children. They provide professional counselling programs through registered counsellors and mental health practitioners.

They also provide social services through their own registered social workers and trained, qualified teachers and caregivers for the children while their care is secure for level level education and caregiving.

Grand Gateway Gateway aims to assist Compass to provide residential care (housing), food, education, health care and safe environment to women and children who are in need of care. The purpose is to give the current refuge home where women and children who have suffered abuse or violence can feel safe to rebuild a constructive life for themselves.

Grand Gateway Gateway has donated \$50,000 to Compass. This gave them an ability to continue serving needs for the homeless especially during the health crisis when most companies were closed and there was limited funds. The financial aid enabled them to continue providing shelter, medical care, counselling and career guidance to empower women to create a better future for themselves and their children.





# KITSO LESEDI YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Kitsi Lesedi Youth Development is a non-profit organization that aims to up-tilt the youth of South Africa to alleviate poverty. Their goal is to skill and train youth from disadvantaged areas through social development and skills based programmes so they may one day become champions of their communities and lead them to a better tomorrow.

The focus of this CSI programme is to train and capacitate the management, employees and third beneficiaries of the project on various aspects of business. Their programs are designed to educate the youth with management, business, ICT and African Skills. Grand Gaming/Gaming aims to assist this organization to continue to reach more communities through social and skills based programmes, and provide easy access to information through guidance, mentoring and technology.

In 2020, Grand Gaming Gaming donated R100 000 which will be applied through the implementation of programmes such as ICT skills training and continue to improve the conditions of their premises in order for them to provide a good and healthy environment for all. # MOUDUZI MEMORIAL

Mouduzi Memorial Hospital is a community-based organization that deals with HIV/AIDS program in the community of Vrededorp and surrounding areas. The organization was established in 2002 by a group of parents comprised of community leaders and professionals who obliged to play a meaningful role in the plight of HIV/AIDS orphans and vulnerable children.

Grand Gaming Casino donated R100 000 to the organization. To date, Grand Gaming has donated over R200 000 to the organization which has been used to equip their infrastructure and make needed resources for their day to day operations. # KHANYA FAMILY CENTRE

**KHANYA FAMILY CENTRE** is a South African Not for Profit community mental health care organisation that has been providing accessible psychological services for children and families in the townships of Durban East, east of Johannesburg since 1984. Khanya is "healing through hope" shapes experiences, empathy and passion—they believe that emotional and mental wellbeing is a key step in managing and rebuilding the lives of affected individuals, families and communities.

Grand Gateway Gateway has donated R20 000 to the Khanya Family Centre to enable them to continue to provide psychological counselling and support services to children, adults and families experiencing life challenges, including those affected and infected by HIV/AIDS. They also facilitate the process of capacity building for community members to promote their own life thinking, growth and self-reliance.



# REARABILWE EKHURHULENI COMMUNITY CARE

Rearabilwe is a South Sotho word which means "They have been answered". Rearabilwe Ekhurhuleni Community Care (RECC) is a community-based organisation working with orphaned and vulnerable children (OVCs) affected or infected by HIV/AIDS.

Grand Gateway Clothing has donated R75 000 to assist the organisation to provide orphaned and vulnerable children with psychosocial support and a social safety net for these children and their families. The programme uses a developmental approach that ensures that there is sustainability in the lives of the beneficiaries.





# UCPA SA

The United Cerebral Palsy Association of Missouri established in 1961 and has been taking care of children with Cerebral Palsy. Many of the children are abandoned and others referred by the Department of Health. The UCPA provides 24 hour care which includes stimulation, therapy and other specialized treatments all afforded by cerebral palsy. The United Cerebral Palsy Association of South Africa (Mary Reader Center) is home to a 60 children and young adults who suffer the effects of Profound Cerebral Palsy, all of whom require and receive round-the-clock care. Most residents have been abandoned or orphaned and come from all over South Africa (Open to age upwards).

Grand Gaming Gaming donated R100 000 to the organization.

To date, Grand Gaming Gaming has donated over R200 000 to assist the organization in providing specialized nursing care, medical care, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, aqua therapy, music therapy, recreational therapy, food, clothing, other necessities and above all a home they can call their own with "mothers" who love them and help them reach their full potential.
